RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11 - Adoption of Streetlight Adjustment Fee

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS, SUPPORTING AND APPROVING THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE MONTHLY STREETLIGHT FEE TO \$9.50 PER STREETLIGHT PLUS APPLICABLE PCRFB FEES; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION ON MARCH 1, 2026; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tatum provides streetlighting services for the benefit and safety of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing streetlighting has increased due to higher utility rates and Power Cost Recovery Factor (PCRFB) charges; and

WHEREAS, the current streetlight fee of \$5.50 per streetlight per month is insufficient to cover the City's actual cost; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to adjust the streetlight fee to ensure continued service and financial sustainability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

The City Council hereby approves and supports the adjustment of the monthly streetlight fee to \$9.50 per streetlight, plus applicable PCRFB fees.


SECTION 2.

The revised fee shall take effect on April 1, 2026, and shall be reflected on the monthly water bills issued by the City of Tatum.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


